



Fox Valley Surgical is an independently owned, ten surgeon group, located in Appleton, WI, recruiting for a Vascular Surgeon.

All Physicians within our practice have done surgical subspecialty fellowships. We have four fellowship trained vascular surgeons who all maintain a very busy practice. Two of these surgeons will be retiring in the next year and a half; therefore, we are looking to recruit their replacements. Currently all FVSA Physicians practice general surgery as well as their subspecialties; nevertheless, we are open to having a vascular surgeon who concentrates solely on vascular.

Our practice is primarily located at Appleton Medical Center, a 147 bed community hospital with most of the medical and surgical subspecialties represented on the medical staff. We refer burns, serious trauma, transplant and pediatric patients, but care for almost all other patients. We have a very active cardiology and cardiac surgery program and our vascular surgeons share the new hybrid OR for endovascular cases. Our vascular surgeons also provide all of the vascular care at St. Elizabeth's Hospital, a similarly sized hospital located on the south side of Appleton, run by Affinity Health System/Ascension Health.

Appleton is a city of approximately 70,000 people; our referral area encompasses the entire Fox Valley, with a population of about 250,000 people. The Appleton schools and outlying area schools are highly ranked with many extracurricular activities offered within the school and community, which makes Appleton a great place to raise a family. It is home to Lawrence University, Fox Valley Technical College and a two year branch of the University of Wisconsin, which helps provide many cultural and educational opportunities for the community.

Our position offers full benefits and a competitive salary. Our practice is also willing to help support the fellow while they continue forward with their training. Our new hires are customarily employed for two years with the expectation that they become partner within the corporation there after.
